Position Overview

The Roofing Service Foreman is a key leader within the Service Division, responsible for managing field operations including diagnosing roof issues, conducting repairs, and completing small-scope projects.

Key Responsibilities (Essential Duties and Functions)

The criteria for evaluation in this position include, but are not limited to, the following:

Performs daily supervision of crew members and equipment as follows:

- Diagnose and repair commercial roof leaks accurately and efficiently.
- Execute defined-scope repairs and preventative maintenance work on all major roofing systems including EPDM, TPO, PVC, Modified Bitumen, BUR, coatings, sheet metal, shingles, and foam systems.
- Lead service crews on job sites, ensuring compliance with Chemcote's/client's safety policies and quality standards.
- Manage site documentation, similar but not limited to scope paperwork, daily logs, time sheets, and production reports.
- Communicate job progress daily (at a minimum) or as necessary/required, which includes, but not limited to material requirements, and crew performance updates to the Service Manager.
- Ensure proper job site setup, safety procedures, and equipment operation.
- Train and mentor crew members, fostering a team-oriented work culture.
- Respond quickly to emergency calls, including after-hours/weekend requests.
- Attend all scheduled meetings and submit required paperwork on time.
- Maintain a professional, courteous demeanor with clients and team members.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Display a professional and courteous attitude toward co-workers, supervisors, clients, etc. at all times.
- Must be willing to work nights and weekends when necessary/required.
- Report to the assigned location ready to begin work at the designated start time.
- Strict adherence to safety requirements and procedures as outlined in the Chemcote Safety and Fire Prevention Program Handbook and/or client's requirements/programs.
- Strict adherence to Chemcote policies and procedures as outlined in the Employee Handbook.
- Willingness to work in a team environment and assist co-workers or supervisors with other duties as required.
- Timely, regular attendance and reliable transportation is an expectation of performance for all Chemcote employees. Employees will be held accountable for adhering to their workplace schedule.
- Must be willing to take and pass a drug screening, similar but not limited to pre-employment, post-accident, randoms or as deemed necessary by the Chemcote CEO and/or President.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily.

Education/Experience

High school diploma or GED required. Technical training or certifications in construction/roofing is a

plus.

- Minimum 3–5 years of construction/roofing experience, with at least 1–2 years in a supervisory or lead role.
- Proven experience as a Leader in the construction industry.
- Strong understanding of various roofing manufacture installation procedures, flashing, sheet work and membrane systems.
- Ability to read/understand blueprints, project plans, and roofing specifications.
- Certification or training in construction management or a related field is preferred.
- Prefer familiarity with scheduling and project management software.
- Experience in cost control, budget management, and resource allocation is highly recommended.
- Strong goal-oriented objectives.

Work Requirements

- Strong proficient understanding of roofing techniques/processes, details, design and manufacture requirements.
- Ability to read and interpret construction/roofing manufacture design documents and specifications.
- Proficient in construction processes, roofing techniques, roofing equipment, hand tools, etc.
- Knowledge and understanding of safety regulations and a commitment to maintaining a safe work environment.
- Ability to problem-solve, make decisions, and adapt to changing project conditions.
- Must possess the ability to be actively involved in job site activities and inspections.
- Must be available to work flexible hours and travel to different job sites within Central Ohio.
- Proficient in reading and interpreting project plans, blueprints, and specifications.
- Strong leadership and decision-making skills with the ability to manage and motivate a team.
- Excellent time management, organizational, and communication skills.
- Certifications: OSHA 30; First Aid/CPR

Knowledge/Skill Requirements

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write and communicate with simple correspondence using the English language. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to customers, clients, and other employees of the organization.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:

REASONING ABILITY:

OTHER:

A valid Ohio driver's license and reliable daily transportation are required for this position.
